Our Speakers...

Saturday 28th July 2007

Michael Glickman - is a much-loved, respected and influential figure of the crop circle community, whose work on the geometry and interpretation of the crop circles has spanned over 16 years. A renowned and inspirational speaker and writer; he has long occupied a central space at the heart of research into this phenomenon. Michael has written many articles on the crop circles. His book, **Crop Circles** (published by Wooden Books), is now in its third revised edition and two further books, **The Bones of God** and **Cornography**, are about to be published. Michael will give his annual address on his latest discoveries.

Marilyn Penrod MA - hails from North Carolina USA and is a lecturer on crop circles and other metaphysical phenomena. Her passion for spiritual study, the paranormal and alternative medicine has led her not only to Britain, but the South-western United States and Brazil, to the enclave of famed healer Joao de Deus. In North Carolina, she is the creator and proprietor of a community healing arts centre. As a career communications designer and artist, Marilyn is both drawn to and delighted by the visual perfection of crop circles. Marilyn will be talking about her research into crop circles and water.

Glenn & Cameron Broughton - Glenn sees the world of Earth Mysteries as a pathway to both universal truths and ones own personal spirituality. Glenn and is a skilled and experienced dowser who believes that ancient sacred sites and the modern mystery of the crop circles open up access to an unseen world that underlies reality. Cameron is a 'people person', massage therapist, healer and mother. She is also a spiritual seeker and adventurer. They have combined to form **Sacred Britain**, facilitating tours to the UK and organising the US East Coast Crop Circle Conference. See - www.sacredbritain.com. Glenn is well known for his entertaining, but thoughtful presentations and this will be Cameron's first time speaking alongside her husband in the UK. Their presentation is entitled: **Earth Spirit: whisperings from a ley-line**.

Daniel Pinchbeck - is the author of **Breaking Open the Head: A journey into the Heart of Contemporary Shamanism**, 2003, and **2012: The Year of Mayan Prophecy**, 2007 which included some of his experiences with the crop circles. His writing has appeared in The New York Times Magazine, Rolling Stone, Wired, and many other publications. He is a founder of the Evolver Project, (www.evo.net), which supports and advocates socially and ecologically responsible commerce. Daniel is one of our most exciting and innovative modern-day thinkers and intellectuals. His talk is entitled: **Field Effects: Crop circles as markers of psychic transformation**.

Sunday 29th July 2007

Karen Alexander - has for many years brought a gentle and introspective touch to researching the crop circles. A respected and influential speaker and writer, her work seamlessly fuses sacred art, spirituality, psychology and philosophy. Karen is perhaps best known as the writer behind the **Crop Circle Year Books**, 1999 - 2006 and **Crop Circles: Signs, Wonders & Mysteries**, 2006. Karen will give her annual presentation about her latest work and thoughts.

Dan Vidler - is a relative newcomer to the crop circle field, but his photography inside the crop circles and his meticulous attention to detail is fast winning him much deserved respect. His website www.ukcropcircles.co.uk is becoming a popular destination for researchers. Dan says: "My decision to create the website came about through a lack of available facts about the crop circles each year. Aerial photos provided us with a visual picture of each design, but missing were details and first hand evidence from the ground. My aim is to provide this essential information, enabling people to 'know' more and 'speculate' less" Dan will be taking us through the close-detail of some of the latest crop circles.

Robin Heath - Robin Heath is an independent researcher into ancient science, specialising in the megalithic culture of Neolithic Europe. Widely known on the lecture circuit as a witty and lively presenter, Robin has published several radical books on this and related topics, and is currently an honorary research fellow at the University of Wales, Lampeter, where he also teaches on an MA course in Archaeoastronomy and Landscape Archaeology. He also undertakes tours to megalithic and sacred sites with Irene Earis, see www.skyandlandscape.com. Robin's presentation entitled: **Set in Stone: The Hidden Geometry of Stone Circles**, will set out to draw links between the geometry of ancient stone monuments and the modern-day crop circle phenomenon.
