Walking in the Crop Circles: There can be no substitute for a first-hand visit to the crop circles. Experiencing their enigmatic spaces and spending time discovering how the circles affect you and your emotions can be truly rewarding. This is an opportunity to visit the crop circles as part of a group with two experienced researchers as your guides. A great introduction to the phenomenon. Visit two-three crop circles; transport, guide and payments to farmers included in the price.

Physical Fitness:

This tour may involve some sustained walking on uneven ground to reach the crop circles we visit and a moderate level of fitness will be required.

Equipment you will need to bring:

You will need a good pair of walking shoes. You may also need to be prepared for wet weather, a light waterproof jacket would be useful. Conversely, if the weather is set hot and fair consider bringing a sun hat and sun lotion, there is no shade in the middle of a crop field! An umbrella for rain protection, or used as a sun shade might be handy. A bottle of drinking water might also be useful.

Camera Equipment:

Please feel free to bring cameras or video-cameras to take some pictures of your visit. However, remember you will have to carry your equipment. Bear in mind that you should be able to carry whatever you bring comfortably - don't overload!

Lunch:

The tour will break for a delicious cold buffet lunch served by the Divine Cafe in the Coronation Hall in Alton Barnes.

Important Practicalities:

It might seem obvious, but there are no public toilets at our locations (out in the middle of the countryside), so please plan accordingly.
